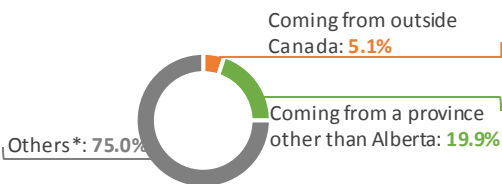
Education, median income and unemployment (population 15 years and over)



Occupations (population 15 years and over)

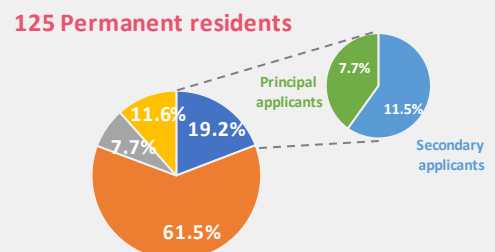
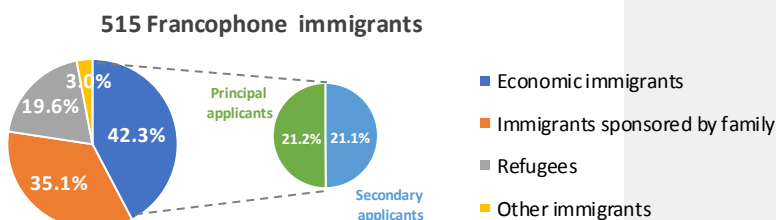


Mobility status 5 years prior to 2016

Admission category and applicant type



"Admission category" refers to the name of the immigration program or group of programs under which an immigrant has been granted for the first time the right to live in Canada permanently by immigration authorities.

"Applicant type" refers to whether an immigrant was identified as the principal applicant, the spouse or the dependant on the application for permanent residence.
